The passage of SB #1728 aka SB#2279 will ultimately provide a roadmap to a new approach on proper trauma care for individuals who suffer major, life-threatening injury.

The passage of the bill will undoubtedly address two very important concerns of the country:

1. The lack of state-of-the art Trauma Care for the Filipino people; and
2. Effective and reliable Trauma Care is crucial to the country's tourism and retirement and business industries.

FILIPINOS DESERVE THE BEST TRAUMA CARE

Trauma is a surgical disease that is the leading cause of death in persons 1 through 44 years of age. Injury is a disease. It has a host (eg, a patient personally known or unknown to you Senator, a visiting tourist, a brother, sister or a close relative, an average ordinary Juan De La Cruz, a soldier, a military personnel, a government official, a store owner, an employee, a priest, a deacon, a chaplain, a Kof C, a freemason, a mayor, Governor or a Congressperson) and) and it has vector, a mode of transmission (eg, a motor vehicle, a firearm, a fall, etc).

Significantly, more than 90% of vehicular accidents occur in the developing world, the Philippines included.

One only has to look at the hundreds of daily vehicular mishaps involving motorcycles in the metropolis alone and the resulting injury/deaths to see how serious the problem is.

By passing a law enthusiastically adopting an Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) course teaching appropriate and timely care, Congress could significantly improve the chances for survival of injured patients and reduce the number of trauma- related deaths.

Across the world, the ATLS method is the accepted standard of care for "first hour" of trauma care delivery by many who provide care for the injured, whether the patient is treated in an isolated rural area or a state-of the-art trauma center.

SB No. 1728 aka 2279 seeks to improve Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care by: (a) empowering the Department of Health to identify designated Trauma centers; (b) establishing a National Clearinghouse on Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care; and (c) providing trauma care center standards.

Under this roadmap, an organized National Committee on Trauma (COT) could be created to promulgate an ATLS program for the government and non-government healthcare industry, military agencies, teaching University Hospitals, private hospitals in the cities, in urban, suburban and rural areas with the Imprimatur of the 16th Congress Passage of SB 1728 formerly 15th Congress SB 2279.

To date, 47 countries are actively providing the ATLS course. The following places around the Philippines have existing ATLS programs: [Hong Kong](#) (ACS Chapter and Committee on Trauma), [Indonesia](#) (Indonesian Surgeons' Association), [Pakistan](#) (College of Physicians and Surgeons), [Papua New Guinea](#) (Royal Australian College of Surgeons), [Taiwan](#) (Surgical Association of the Republic of Taiwan), [Republic of Singapore](#) (Chapter of Surgeons, Academy of Medicine), [Thailand](#) (Royal College of Surgeons of Thailand), [Vietnam](#), [India](#) and Mainland China.

THE SUCCESS OF THE TOURISM AND RETIREMENT INDUSTRIES DEPEND ON RELIABLE TRAUMA CARE

The Philippines is fast emerging as a world-class tourist and retirement destination. We do not lack in beautiful sites and a friendly people. The tourism and retirement industries can spell the difference on whether the country can finally take off and be the next financial tiger in Asia. Millions of jobs can be created and a countless amount generated by these two interrelated industries for national development.

Unfortunately, the absence of world-class trauma care in the country greatly impacts on the decision of tourists and retirees to come to the Philippines. For most tourists and retirees, safety and medical concerns are the biggest factors when deciding to visit or retire in another country. The absence of such a basic medical need puts our country at a terrible disadvantage compared to the foregoing countries/destinations outside the Philippines that have existing ATLS programs. This might explain why most, if not all, of the said countries have greatly higher tourist arrivals compared to the Philippines.

It is for these reasons that we urge you to please shepherd this very important bill through the 16th Congress. Filipinos must be able to rely on Congressional passage of SB 1728 aka formerly 2279 to achieve proper Emergency Medical Service and Trauma Care Management in their country when they become victims of Trauma-related injury.

Passage of SB 1728 aka 2279 formerly will resolve troubling levels of Trauma Care and Management with its limited portrayal in every surgical service in the Philippines. SB 1728 will establish a roadmap to the application of Advanced Trauma Life Support and its derivation of Levels Trauma of Care (L1, L2, L3, L4) known to Improve Emergency Medical Services And Trauma Care Management.

Pass Senate Bill #-2279 Now : AN ACT TO IMPROVE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND TRAUMA CARE IN THE PHILIPPINES.

Current statutes of Trauma Care and Management in the Philippines are not adequately addressed. Its limited portrayal in every surgical service need to be recognized to allow a definite roadmap to the application of Advanced Trauma Life Support and its derivation of Trauma Levels of care applicable to every hospital. Philippine Senator Miriam Defensor Santiago introduced Senate Bill 2279 which seeks to improve Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care by: (a) empowering the Department of Health to identify designated trauma centers, (b) establishing a National Clearinghouse on Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care; and (c) providing for standards with respect to trauma care centers. A quick call to action by signing this petition to Tell the 16th Congress that it is about time to act quickly and pass Senate Bill 1728 previously SB 2279.
